Euchre Club

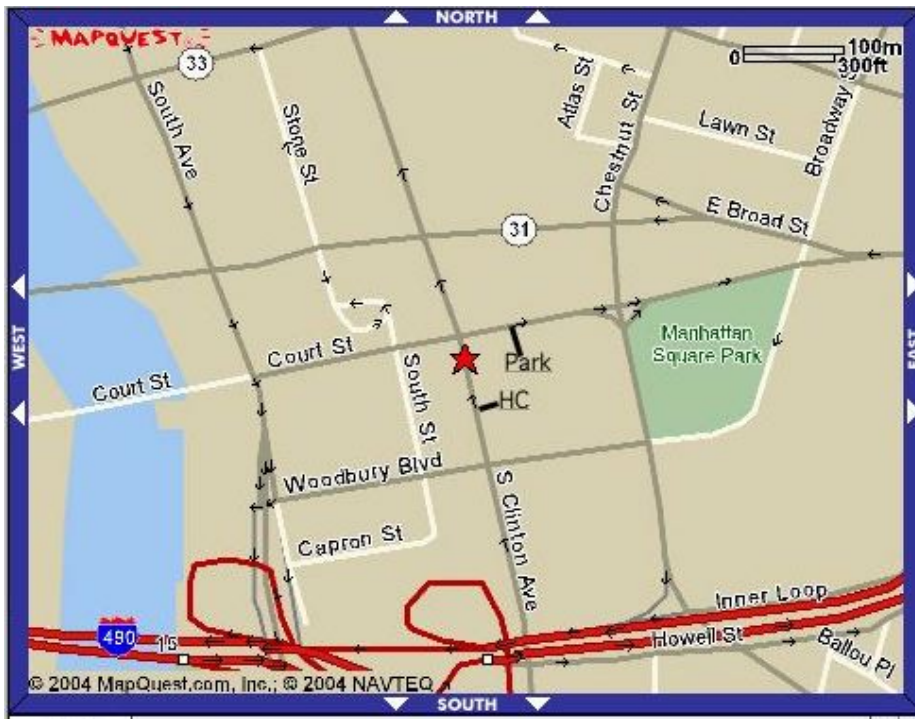
